Annual World Pulse Impact Report

World Pulse believes in the power of digital connection to spark personal transformation and collective action.

Through our rigorous monitoring, evaluation, and learning (MEL) methodology, we track how digital empowerment translates into real-world impact for women across the globe.

We analyze platform data, community feedback, and responses to our annual impact survey to understand how our network strengthens women's voices, fosters meaningful connections, and expands access to resources, ultimately supporting women to lead change.

This report presents insights from 420 survey respondents, alongside an analysis of the 5,287 most active members in 2024.



Platform demographics

World Pulse is made up of more than **85,000** members across five continents. Of members who joined in 2024, 77% live in countries that score "Poor" or "Very Poor" on progress toward gender equality, according to the <u>2024 SDG Gender Index by Equal Measures 2030</u>.








What inspires her to join?

Impact at a Glance


- 3 out of 4 members surveyed report that because of their involvement with World Pulse they took action
- 88% of members surveyed felt more supported by others
- 74% report that the actions they took as a result of their involvement with World Pulse made an impact
- 72% report World Pulse helped them build their confidence

Our Theory of Change

World Pulse believes that when women are digitally empowered on 3 key pillars (i.e., if women gain a Voice, find Connections, and have access to Resources), they will **act to change the world.**

Our digital empowerment framework is based on more than 12 years of internal evaluation and external research conducted with our community, as well as consultation with our community and experts in the sector.





Voice

World Pulse believes that having a platform to speak and access greater voice improves lives. This pillar reflects an overall year-over-year growth of 4% relative to 2023.









As an orphaned girl who longed to be heard, World Pulse became my voice when I had none. Through this platform, I found a safe space to share my struggles, dreams, and hopes. It connected me with a global community of women who listened, encouraged, and empowered me. Our digital empowerment framework shows that when women are connected and encourage each other, they are better supported to take action. This pillar reflects an overall year-over-year growth of 3% relative to 2023.











At World Pulse, women exchange resources and opportunities that further enable them to act for change. This pillar reflects an overall year-over-year growth of 8% relative to 2023.














